Sayyiduna Anas Ibn Malik (radiyallahu'anhu) reports that Rasulullah (sallallahu 'alayhi wa sallam) would recite the following supplication when the Month of Rajab would commence:

اللَّهُمَّ بَارِكْ لَنَا فِي رَجَبٍ وَشَعْبَانَ وَبَلِّغْنَا رَمَضَانَ

Allahumma baarik lana fi Rajabin wa Sha'bana wa balligh-na Ramadan

**Translation:** Oh Allah! Grant us Barakah (Blessing) during (the months of) Rajab and Sha'ban, and allow us to reach Ramadan. (Shu'abul-Iman, Hadith: 3534, Ibnu Sunni, Hadith: 660, Mukhtasar Zawaid Bazzar, Hadith: 662, also see Al-Adhkar, Hadith: 549)
